Our Musical Theatre Intensive camp weeks are geared towards students with multiple levels of dance, voice, and theatre experience. Campers in grades 7–12 (June 4-8 is grades 6-10) will have the unique opportunity to work with Broadway Palm’s resident Choreographer, Amy McCleary, and occasionally with actors from current Broadway Palm shows. Each week of Musical Theatre Intensive camp culminates with a performance at the Broadway Palm Dinner Theatre facilities (except for June 4-8). Campers will also attend Broadway Palm’s current productions. We look forward to seeing many friendly faces of returning campers, but also hope to see lots of new ones. Tell your friends!

This summer four themed weeks are geared towards all skill levels and abilities for 7<sup>th</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup> graders. The final week is geared toward 7<sup>th</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup> graders who are highly advanced and looking to pursue a career in the performing arts. One additional week is offered for grades 6<sup>th</sup> – 10<sup>th</sup> and geared towards those who are beginning or want a refresher.

Please bring a bag lunch, snack, and water bottle/thermos (no refrigeration available). Students should wear dance clothes or rehearsal clothes (no jeans) and jazz shoes, ballet slippers, dance shoes or sneakers. No flip flops or sandals.

## **The Weekly Themes!**

### **Seussical (June 4-8) Grades 6 - 10**

Join us for a special week for our younger students as we dive into the world of Dr. Seuss. Students will enjoy one on one lessons with the cast of Broadway Palm’s Seussical and Ring of Fire - concentrating on acting through a song, comedy, instrumental training, musical theatre dance and more! Campers will attend our production of Seussical and participate in a final performance in the Broadway Palm rehearsal space featuring songs and dances from the show.

### **Annie – Act One (July 9 - 13) Grades 7 - 12**

Leapin' lizards! Everyone's favorite orphan is back at the Broadway Palm. This week we will learn dances, songs and scenes from Broadway Palm's production of Annie! Get inspired by attending a performance of the show followed by a question and answer session with the cast. This week we will focus on scenes and songs from the first act of the show. Students will use improv exercises to help create over the top characters. Specialty courses in tap, music theory and scene study will be offered by professional Broadway Palm actors. The camp will culminate in a final performance on the Broadway Palm stage.

### **Annie – Act Two (July 16 - 20) Grades 7 - 12**

For our second week of Annie mayhem we will focus on songs and scenes from the second act. Students will get to attend the show and have one on one lessons with cast members - focusing on vocal technique and how to prepare for auditions. Learn what it's like to be a professional actor from the cast and work on choreography from the show! It all wraps up with a performance on the Broadway Palm stage complete with sets, props and professional lighting.

### **Mamma Mia! (July 23 – 27) Grades 7 - 12**

Work with Broadway Palm's resident director and choreographer, Amy McCleary, on songs and dances from her production of Mamma Mia! Travel to a Grecian isle and sing the hits of ABBA in songs and scenes from this pop/rock show. If you loved the movie, you'll love the musical! Students will attend Broadway Palm's production of Annie and work with cast members on audition technique, dance partnering, acrobatics and advanced vocal techniques such as riffing and pop/rock style. The week ends with a performance on the Broadway Palm stage with scenes and songs from Mamma Mia!

### **Broadway Palm Season Guide - Advanced (July 30 – Aug. 3) Grades 7 - 12**

This camp is for students who are looking to pursue a career in the performing arts. Actors will be pushed to perform at the peak of their abilities with advanced part singing, partner dancing, and a variety of scene work based on Broadway Palm's 2017/2018 season including Pippin, Chicago, Mamma Mia, My Fair Lady, Ring of Fire, and Annie! Students will dive into the history of musical theatre and become familiar with each show - learning historical context and how to audition for varying genres. Students will also attend a performance of Annie followed by a question and answer session with the cast. Professional actors from Broadway Palm will work with students one on one on audition technique, musical theatre history, music theory, vocal technique and style and a variety of dance forms. The final performance on the Broadway Palm stage will feature each student in a role from our previous season.
